This November, you'll have a chance to preserve Brevard by voting to buy environmentally endangered lands that:

- **preserve open greenspace**
- **protect our drinking water**
- **enhance natural areas like the Indian River Lagoon**
- **protect Brevard from Miami-style overdevelopment**

Rapid growth and development is occurring throughout our county. Let's keep Brevard beautiful by preserving forever those natural areas essential to our quality of life. Brevard's Environmentally

Endangered Lands (EEL) Program has wide public support because citizen scientists oversee the process, preserving areas like the Archie Carr Sea Turtle Refuge, Enchanted Forest, Maritime Hammock, Pine Island, and Turkey Creek.

But the existing EEL Program can't afford to meet critical conservation goals. With funds from a new bond referendum, additional lands can be preserved to protect vital water recharge areas and Indian River Lagoon water quality.

We can do this without paying any more in taxes — the new bond referendum will use the same tax currently collected for the Beach & Riverfront Program ending

next year. The cost is about \$17 for the average homeowner.*
